

# Department of Lifelong Learning & Extension (DLLE) Annual Report for the Academic Year 2020-2021



#### Vision and Mission: - "Reach to Unreached".

The Department of Lifelong Learning and Extension strives to imbibe human skills among the students by engrossing them in activities beneficial for community upliftment. We try to work for the under privileged sections of the society and strive to transform the University system into an active instrument for social change through the institutionalization of extension as the third dimension. During this adverse Pandemic Time, we tried our best to be connected with our students online.

#### **Objectives for the year:**

- To stay connected with the students during the time of pandemic.
- To design activities that would help students perform extension activities with ease.
- To create awareness to fight the tough times and reduce the anxiety levels among the students.
- To enhance the inbuilt skills and leadership qualities of the student by giving opportunity of event management.

#### **Selection of the Extension Projects: -**

- We carried out two projects from <u>Vocational Career Oriented Project</u> Career Project (CP) and Anna Poorna Yojana (APY) and two projects from <u>Community Oriented</u> <u>Project</u> Survey of Women's Status (SWS) and Population Education Club (PEC) through online mode.
- This year 49 students participated in the activity out of which 14 students participated in Career Project (CP), 5 students participated in Anna Poorna Yojana (APY), 20 students participated in Survey of Women's Status (SWS), 10 students participated in Population Education Club (PEC).

### **Summary of Extension Activities: -**

- The Orientation Programme organized on zoom platform on 16<sup>th</sup> August, 2020 to make new students familiar with the Department of Lifelong Learning and Extension.
- The First Term Training Programme at college level to allot different projects and elect student manger was conducted through regular online meets through Zoom from 26-31<sup>st</sup> August 2020.
- 2 students were appointed as Student Managers who bridged the gap between Extensions Students & Extension Work Teachers.
- ➤ DLLE committees' member's first meetings conducted on 14<sup>th</sup> August, 2020 and second meeting on 8<sup>th</sup> January, 2021, for planning and reviews of extension activities respectively.
- This year due to the pandemic ease was given to students to complete their activity projects in an easy online mode.
- The Students of CP were asked to prepare Power Point Presentation (PPT) on the career of their choice,
- The SWS students were asked to write Essay or Report highlighting the Role of Women in Today's world the challenges and opportunities they face every day.
- The students participating in Anna Poorna Yojna (APY) were asked to Submit 4 easy to cook recipes in Power Point Presentation (PPT) or word form.
- The Population Education Club (PEC) students were asked to make a small PPT on the cross-cutting any social problem/issue.
- The Second Term Training Programme at college level was organized to evaluate the project works on 8<sup>th</sup> January, 2021 through Zoom.
- Power Point Presentation & Motivational Videos on social issues were prepared and presented by the students of PEC Activity on 5<sup>th</sup> March, 2021.
- On the occasion of World Consumer Right Day a consumer awareness programme was conducted by the DLLE and Commerce department where students gave speeches on raising consumer awareness and the concept of consumerism on 15<sup>th</sup> March, 2021.
- When the College started offline with 50% capacity rules of COVID-19 Pandemic an offline meet of the students was arranged to discuss about the activities that would

- help students to reenergize after the long lockdown. The Outcome of the meet was that it was decided to conduct a College Fest named UTOPIA.
- With a lot of preparations students carried out decoration, pamphlet designing, campaigning the event and it was successfully conducted from 22<sup>nd</sup> to 27<sup>th</sup> March 2021. The detailed report of which has been attached herewith.
- The Core Projects of the DLLE Activities were submitted by the students by 25<sup>th</sup> April, 2021 and all the university procedures and documentation process was started from 30<sup>th</sup> April, 2021.
- On 12<sup>th</sup> May, 2021 a Webinar was conducted by the DLLE & Commerce department in association with the Consumer Guidance Society of India (CGSI) on the topic Consumerism and Financial Literacy in COVID-19 to guide students in proper use of financial resources during this pandemic and inculcate the habit of saving and investment and turn them into a better consumer and smart investor.

- Through the DLLE platform we could stay connected with students throughout the year.
- The designed programs help students to face life and its challenges and thus create an ambience for a learning society.
- It helped students to reduce their anxiety levels by engaging in activities.




