6.3.1 Curriculum Development:

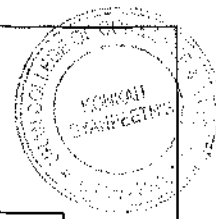

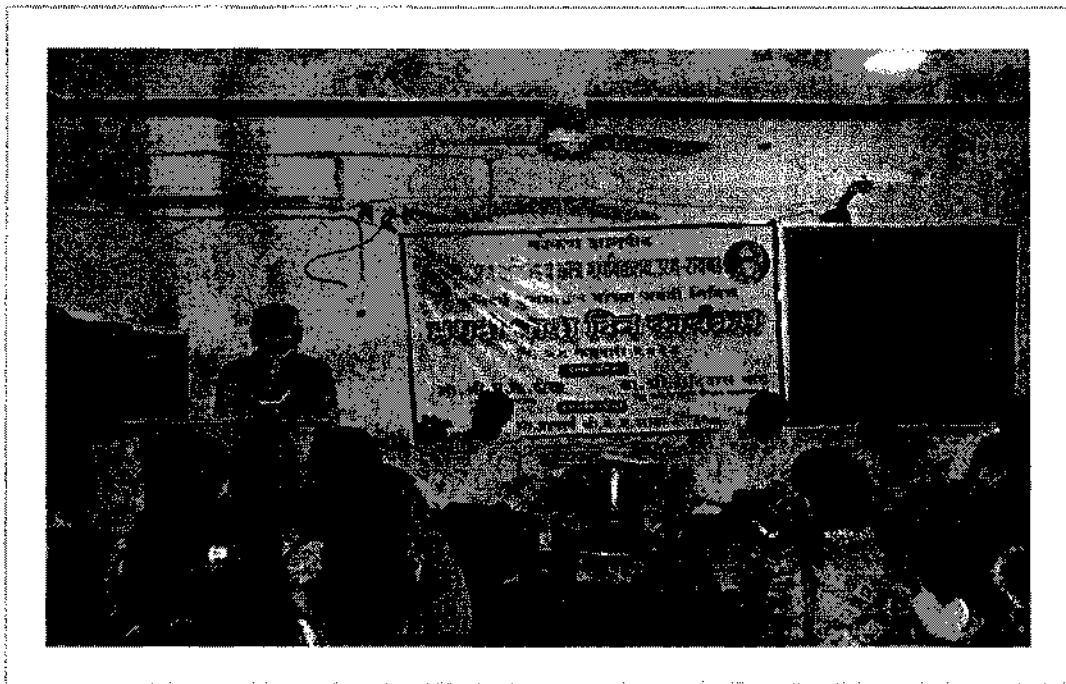

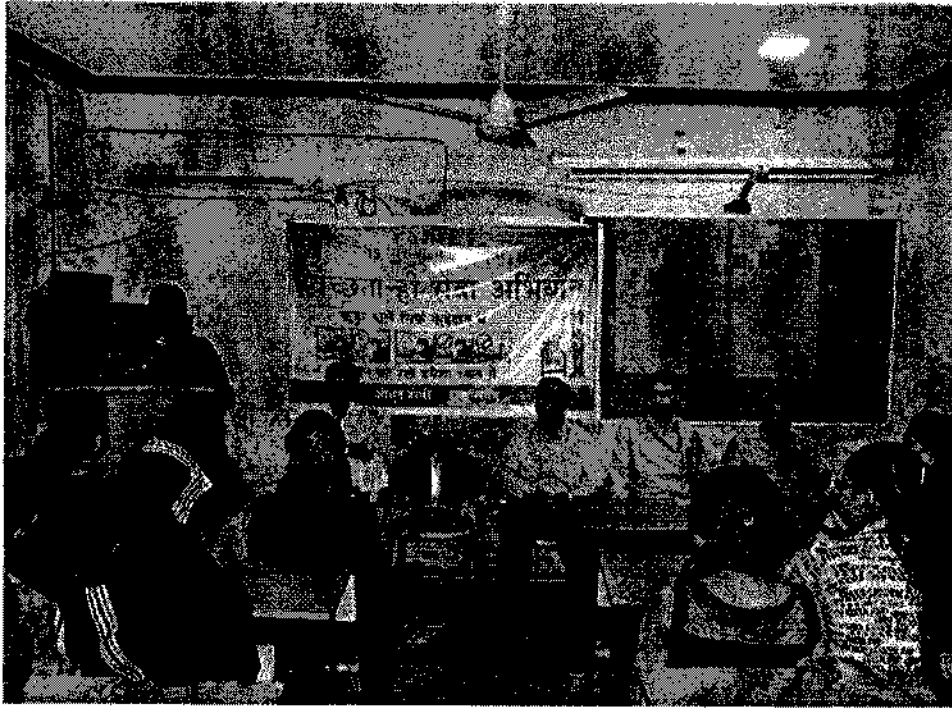

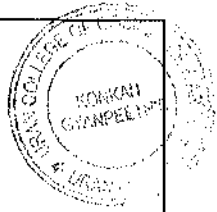

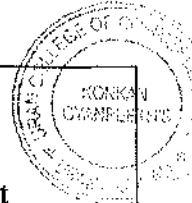
ANNEXTURE - IV

- Below Average - 1


Out of 20 respondents, 10 respondents are selected as sampling. After analyzing the data, following observations are made about our teachers.
