




Analysis of Teachers feedback on curriculum 2020-2021


Q.1. Current syllabus is need based.



13% of teachers opined that they are agreed to current syllabus is need based.




Q.2. Curriculum has current content.



12% of total replied they opined that agreed to curriculum has current content.


Q.3. Programmes outcomes of the syllabus is well defined.



12% of total teachers replied that programmes outcomes of the syllabus is well defined and they agreed.




Q.4. Curriculum having good academic flexibility.



13% of teachers reviewed that they are agreed to curriculum having good academic flexibility.


Q. 5. The course content fulfills the need of students.



12% of teachers opined that they are agreed to the course content fulfills the need of students.




Q. 6. Need of review of the syllabus.



7% of teachers opinion that they are strongly agreed to need of review of the syllabus.


Q.7. The curriculum provides opportunity for the conducting Research and project activities.



12% of teachers viewed that they are agreed to the curriculum provides opportunity for the conducting research and project activities.




Q. 8. The curriculum motivates you to teach effectively.
