Objectives for the year:

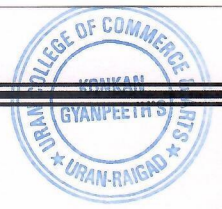
- To stay connected with students during the pandemic online & offline method.
- To design activities that would help students perform extension activities with ease.
- To create awareness to fight the tough times and reduce the anxiety levels among the students.
- To enhance the inbuilt skills and leadership qualities of the student by giving opportunity of event management.

Selection of the Extension Projects: -

- We carried out two projects from **Vocational Career Oriented Project** i.e. Career Project (CP) and Anna Poorna Yojana (APY) and two projects from **Community Oriented Project** i.e. Survey of Women's Status (SWS) and Population Education Club (PEC) through online and offline mode.
- This year 62 students participated in the activity out of which 20 students participated in Career Project (CP), 22 students participated in Anna Poorna Yojana (APY), 07 students participated in Survey of Women's Status (SWS), 09 students participated in Population Education Club (PEC) & 04 students role as Student Managers.

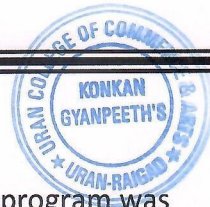
Highlights of Extension Activities: -

- Participation of Students in SWS - 07, CP - 20, PEC - 09, APY - 22 extension projects, and 4 students were appointed as Student Managers who bridged the gap between Extensions Students & Extension Work Teachers.
- This year due to the pandemic ease was given to students to complete their activity projects online as well as offline mode.
- Distributed books on behalf of our college at M. K. Jagtap Commerce, Arts & Science College, Mahad on 28th Oct.2021 due to a natural disaster flood at Mahad, on 22nd July 2021. The cost of the book was Rs. 30750/-.
- We arranged the programs which motivate and create sensitization among the students regarding especially abled children. For this, we arrange activities **selling Diwali Products** in the community. Students actively participated and sold Diwali products of Rs 2050/- & Donation Rs. 500/- for Swami Brahmanand Pratishtan Seabird Special School, Uran. The activity was completed on 1st November 2021. 25 students participated in it.
- As a part of the extension program, **Consumer Guidance & Investment Awareness Seminar** was conducted on 14th December 2021 on the colleges' premises for all B.Com & BAF students in two different batches. The valuable lecture on Consumerism was delivered by Mr. T. R. Pande, Project Manager of CGSI. Financial Literacy issues were discussed very sharply by Mr. Ganesh Bhatt who is the Financial Advisor of CGSI. The seminar overall was very informative and helped students to learn the practicality of Investment Schemes and made them aware and alert about consumerism.
Rs.2000/- were received for two sessions conducted in college accounts and students received a participation certificate. 195 students & 10 teachers participated in this seminar.
- The First Term Training Program at a college level to allot different projects and elect student managers was conducted through Zoom on 21st December 2021.
- On 23rd December 2021, we organized a program of **Glimpse of Tribal Civilization** in association with **Vanvasi Kalyan Ashram Maharashtra**. The Department of Lifelong Learning & Extension has always been striving to achieve its motto of reaching to



unreached by conducting the program for developing social commitment among the students so we reach the untapped community through this program of "Glimpse of Tribal Civilization" (Adivasi Sanskruti Darshan) to make our students know about the most important environmental conservers and their culture.

- Every Year 24th December is observed as **National Consumer Day** with a specific theme in India. On this day the Consumer Protection Act, 1986 had received the assent of the president. The enactment of this Act is considered a historic milestone in the consumer movement in the country. So we celebrated the day by conducting speeches of DLLE Students and share of videos on the importance of National Consumer Day. 55 students participated in this program.
- The Second Term Training Programme was organized at the college level to evaluate the project works on 8th January 2021 through Zoom.
- The First Term Orientation Program organized by DLLE Dept. University of Mumbai on zoom platform on 10th Jan. 2022 to familiarize new students with the Department of Lifelong Learning and Extension Unit.
- DLLE committee members' first term meeting was conducted on 12th July 2021 and the second meeting was held on 11th January 2022, for planning and reviews of extension activities respectively.
- The celebration of **National Voters Day** was organized by the Electoral Literacy Club of Konkan Gyanpeeth Uran College and DLLE unit with the support of Tahsil Office, Uran on 25th January 2022. The unit organized an Oath-taking program & essay writing competition on the occasion of National Voters Day. 30 students participated in this program.
- **UTOPIA Collegiate and Inter-Collegiate festival** was organized by DLLE College Unit and Cultural Department from 7th March to 11th March 2022. We organized 10 events with a lot of preparations by students such as decoration, pamphlet designing, campaigning, registration, and execution of the events, and it was successfully conducted from 7th March to 11th March 2022. The detailed report of which has been attached herewith.



- On the occasion of **World Consumer Right Day**, a consumer awareness program was conducted by the DLLE and Commerce department where students gave speeches on raising consumer awareness and the concept of consumerism on 15th March 2022. On this occasion, 3 students & 2 teachers explained the importance of World Consumer Right Day. One student representative shared 4 videos on consumer issues. 57 students & 9 teachers participated in the said program.
- The Core Projects of the DLLE Activities were submitted by the students till 15th April 2022 and all the university procedures and documentation process was completed by 30th April 2022.

Achievement of DLLE Activities:-

- This year Dept. of Lifelong Learning Extension, University of Mumbai organized UDAAN Festival through online mode for five different competitions. We participated in four and bagged **1st Prize** in Poster Making Competition, **3rd Prize** in Creative Writing & **Consolation Prize** in Powada Singing which was hosted by D.G. Tatkare College, Mangaon Dist. Raigad.
- Miss Singhvi Tisha Devendra(SYBAF) and Miss Kuwawala Misbah Saud (S.Y.B.Com) were awarded as the Best Student Manager in DLLE.
- Miss Mali Prachiti Chandrakant, FY B.Com and Miss Shaikh Muskan Mehboob SYBAF selected as Best Student.
- Organized UTOPIA event successfully for one week within a limited budget.

Outcomes of the year:

- Through the DLLE platform we could stay connected with students throughout the year.
- The designed programs helped students to face life and its challenges and thus create an ambience for a learning society.
- It helped students to reduce their anxiety levels by engaging in activities.
- The activities helped students learn the qualities of effective leadership and event management.

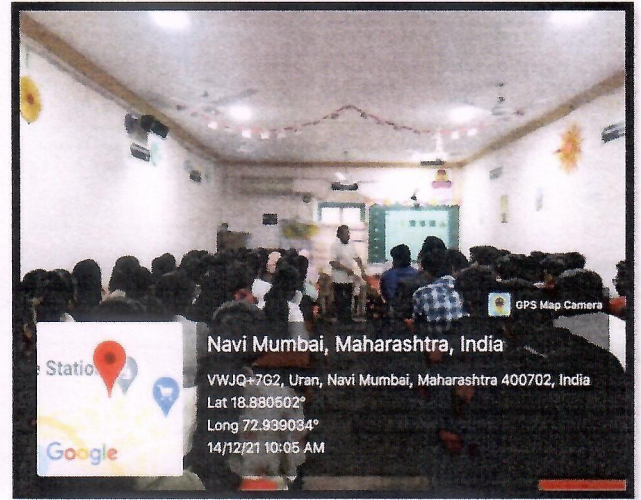
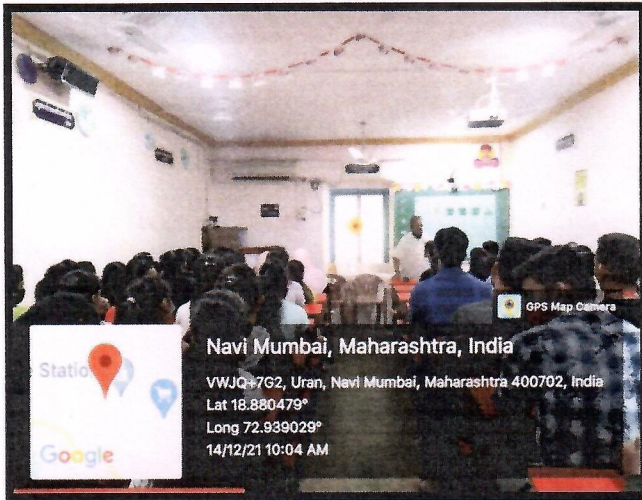

2. Selling of Diwali Products in association with Swami Brahmanand Pratishthan Seabird Special School



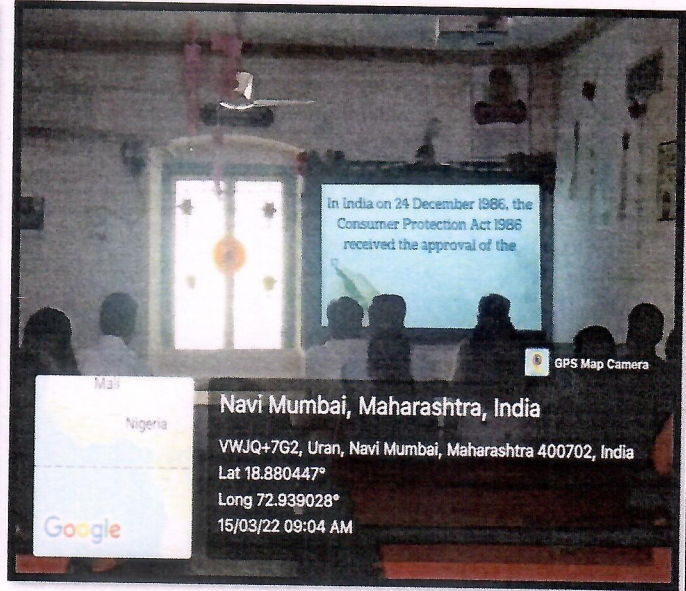
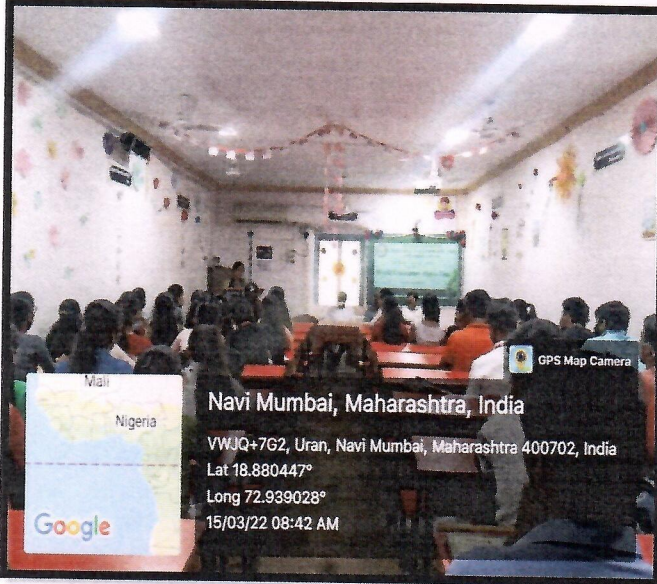

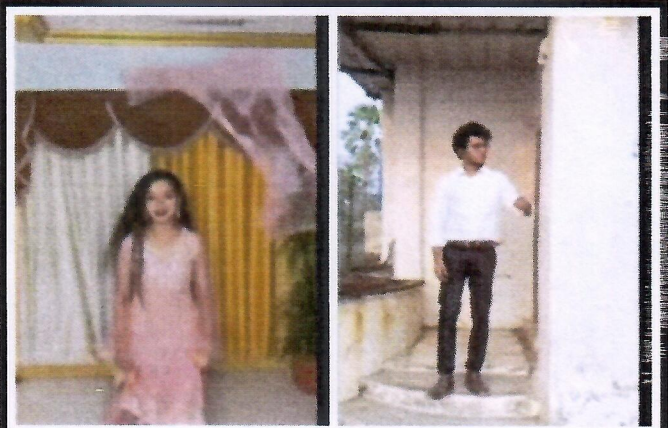
