

Department of Lifelong Learning & Extension (DLLE) Annual Report for the Academic Year 2022-2023



Vision and Mission: - "Reach to Unreached".

The Department of Lifelong Learning and Extension strives to imbibe human skills among the students by engrossing them in activities beneficial for community upliftment. We try to work for the under privileged sections of the society and strive to transform the University system into an active instrument for social change through the institutionalization of extension as the third dimension.

Objectives for the year:

- To design activities that would help students perform extension activities with ease.
- To recreate the pre-pandemic activeness among the students.
- To enhance emotional quotient, the inbuilt skills, leadership qualities of the student by giving opportunity of event management.

Selection of the Extension Projects: -

- We carried out two projects from Vocational Career Oriented Projecti.e. Career Project (CP) and Anna Pourna Yojana (APY) and two projects from Community Oriented Project i.e. Survey of Women's Status (SWS) and Population Education Club (PEC) through offline mode.
- This year 131 students participated in the activity out of which 38 students participated in Career Project (CP), 67 students participated in Anna Poorna Yojana (APY), 16 students participated in Survey of Women's Status (SWS), 06 students participated in Population Education Club (PEC) & 04 students role as Student Managers.

Highlights of Extension Activities: -

- ➤ Participation of Students in SWS 16, CP- 38, PEC- 06, APY 67 extension projects, and 4 students were appointed as Student Managers who bridged the gap between Extensions Students & Extension Work Teachers.
- ➤ DLLE committee members' First term meeting was conducted on 5th July 2022 for planning & budgeting of extension activities.
- ➤ 2 Teachers & 2 Students participated in University **Level First Term Training** at Bhausaheb Nene ASC College Pen on 3rd Aug. 2022.
- ➤ **Sold Rakhis** on the occasion of Raksha Bandhan Rs. 3490/- under APY project from 8th to 10th August, 2022.
- ➤ **Participated in Rally** on the occasion of Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav Celebration at surrounding area Uran on 12th August, 2022.

- As a part of the extension program, 'How to be a Wise Consumer & Smart Investor' was conducted on 23rd August 2022 in the college premises for all B.Com, BAF & BA students in three different batches. The valuable lecture on Consumerism was delivered by Mr. T. R. Pande, Project Manager of CGSI. Financial Literacy issues were discussed very sharply by Dr. Hardeep Kaur. The seminar overall was very informative and helped students to learn the practicality of Investment Schemes and made them aware and alert about consumerism. Rs.3000/- were received for three sessions conducted in college accounts and students received a participation certificate. 265 students & 10 teachers participated in this seminar.
- We conducted **Food Festival** under APY project at college on 26th August 2022.
- Conducted Training of different Projects activities on 13th October, 2022
- ➤ On 18th October 2022, celebrated **Reading Day** in association with Gopal Krishna Library, Deoulwadi Uran. 45 students & 07 teachers participated in this reading day program.
- We arranged the programs which motivated and created sensitization among the students regarding especially abled children. For this, we arranged activities of **Selling Diwali Products** prepared by them in the community. Students actively participated and sold Diwali products of Rs 9295/- & Donation Rs. 500/- for Swami Brahmanand Pratishthan Seabird Special School, Uran. The activity was completed in between on 14th to 22nd October 2022. 40 students participated in it.
- ➤ **Book-Review** by our extension students which were distributed on 18th Oct. 2022. The book-review activities on the occasion of Reading Day were completed on 30th October 2022.
- ➤ DLLE committee members' Second term meeting was conducted on 18th November 2022 for planning and review of extension activities.
- Conducted DLLE Students meeting on 28th November 2022 to discuss about visit at Sea-Bird School Uran, 2nd food festival arrangements, preparation of UDAAN festival & Utopia event etc. 46 students & 2 teachers participated in the said meeting.
- ➤ On 30th November 2022 **Visit at Specially Abled Students** School Bori, Uran. 27 students & 9 teachers participated in the visit.
- ➤ We celebrate **National Consumer Rights Day** on 24th December 2022 every year to spread awareness about consumer rights and responsibilities. Consumer Rights Day is celebrated each year to educate people about their rights as consumers. So we celebrated the day by conducting speeches of DLLE Students and sharing of videos on the importance of National Consumer Day. 55 students participated in this program.
- ➤ The **Second Term Training** Programme was organized at the college level to evaluate the project works of students on 5th Jan 2023.
- ➤ We conducted **Food Festival** under APY project at college on 10th January 2023on the occasion of Annual Sports Day.
- The celebration of **National Voters Day** was organized by the Electoral Literacy Club of Konkan Gyanpeeth Uran College and DLLE unit with the support of Tahsil Office, Uran on 25th January 2023. The unit organized an Oath-taking program, essay

- writing, Rangoli & drawing competition on the occasion of National Voters Day. 12 students and 12 teachers participated in this program.
- ➤ 20 students & 2 teachers participated at **UDAAN Festival** held at Guru Nanak College, G.T.B. Nagar, Sion (E), Mumbai on 31st Jan.2023.
- ▶ UTOPiA Collegiate and Inter-Collegiate festival was organized by DLLE College Unit from 10th to 16th February 2023. We organized 12 events with a lot of preparations by students such as decoration, pamphlet designing, campaigning, registration, and execution of the events, and it was successfully conducted. - ➤ 1 student participated in selection process for Radio Jockey (RJ) for University of Mumbai MUST Radio Channel on 5th April, 2022.
- ➤ On the occasion of **World Consumer Right Day**, a consumer awareness program was conducted by the DLLE and Commerce department where students gave speeches on raising consumer awareness and the concept of consumerism on 28th April 2023. 37 students & 9 teachers participated in the said program.
- ➤ The **Core Projects** of the DLLE Activities were submitted by the students till 25th March 2023 and all the university procedures and documentation process was completed by 2nd May 2023.
- Prof. V. S. Indulkar Extension Work Teacher & Field coordinator delivered training for DLLE students on different Extension Activities at UES Commerce & Science College, Uran, BARNS Arts & Commerce College, Panvel and Arts, Commerce & Science College, Chondhi, Alibag.

- ✓ This year Dept. of Lifelong Learning Extension, University of Mumbai organized UDAAN Festival with five different competitions. We participated in them and bagged 1st Prize in Skit and 2nd Prize in Poster Making Competition, which was hosted by Guru Nanak ASC College, G. B. Nagar, Sion, Mumbai.
- ✓ Miss Ahmed Kahkasha, Thakur Diksha (F.Y. B.Com.) and Miss Singhvi Tisha (TYBAF) were awarded as the Best Extension Student in DLLE.
- ✓ Miss Mhatre Bhumika (M.Com Part II) and Miss Joshi Pratiksha (FYBA) were appreciated for special contribution in DLLE University Udaan Skit competition.
- ✓ Organized UTOPiA event successfully for one week within a limited budget.
- ✓ Participated 1 student selection process for Radio Jockey (RJ) Radio Reporter for University of Mumbai.
- ✓ Prof. V.S.Indulkar has been working as Field Co-ordinator for the Raigad District from the last 15 years (2008-09 to 2022-23) on behalf of Department of Lifelong Learning & Extension, University of Mumbai and was felicitated at the UDAAN festival for his contribution to the department.
