SPECIAL RESIDENTIAL CAMP
Dated- 12th December 2023 to 18th December 2023
Venue- At. Po. Pagote, Taluka- Uran, District- Raigad**

On behalf of the National Service Scheme Department of Konkan Gyanpeeth Uran College of Commerce & Arts, a special residential camp was organized at Pagote, Taluka-Uran and District- Raigad. Completed from 12 December 2023 to 18 December 2023. A brief report of the special camp is as follows:

Dt. 12 December, 2023: All the volunteers arrived at the special residential campsite of the National Service Scheme Department at nine in the morning. The accommodation was prepared & the hall was cleaned. Then in the first session at 10:30 am Hon'ble Shri. V.S. Indulkar Sir took planning & discussion session. He formed five groups of students & explained the whole plan of their work for seven days.

In the afternoon, after lunch, the inauguration program was planned & prepared. The President of the inaugural program was the Secretary & Chief Executive Officer of the Konkan Gyanpeeth organization Hon'ble Mr. Pradipchandra Shringarpure. Hon'ble inaugurated the program, Shri. Prof. Sunil Sushil Shinde (Coordinator, Department of National Planning, University of Mumbai). He said that volunteers of the National Planning Department are nation builders. Hon'ble Mr. Ramesh Thakur (Member College Development Committee) said that the changed lifestyle has increased student negativity. He said that a NSS camp is required to come out of it. Principal Dr. Baliram N. Gaikwad addressed the students. Sarpanch of Pagote Village Hon'ble Mr. Kunal Patil, Hon'ble Mr. Prakash Narayan Bhoir (Member Village Improvement Board) Hon'ble Mr. Satish Patil (Deputy Sarpanch) Hon'ble Mr. Rishikesh Mhatre (Treasurer, Village Improvement Board) Hon'ble Mr. Anant Patil, (Principal R.Z.P) school Pagote, etc. were present. The program was coordinated by Prof. Dr. Datta Hingmire (Programme Officer, National Service Scheme). Welcome & Introduction was done by Prof. Dr. A.R. Chavan (IQAC Coordinator). Mrs. Anupama Kamble gave the vote of thanks. The day ended after the evening meal.

Dt. 13 December 2023: The second day started with detailed guidance on Yoga training & health care by Hon'ble Mr. Ramesh Thakur (Member College Development Committee) & conducted some yoga demonstrations. After that, after tea & breakfast, the volunteers went to the village to clean the village. The village area, graveyard, etc. area was cleaned.

After lunch, in the intellectual session, Prof. Dr. H.K. Jagtap gave a lecture on bamboo production & environmental production. He told about the side effects of



plastic & gave information about bamboo production. After that Hon'ble Swapnil Ratnaparkhi & Hon'ble Suraj Jakapuri informed the students about the banking exam. In the subsequent session, Hon'ble Jitendra Lad presented his thoughts on the topic of Mazya Jagnyache Bal & presented poems on the topics of parents, humanity, love, nature, etc. in a fluent style. Respected Poet Vaibhav Varahdi conveyed the message of the value of education through his poetry. After the meal Prerna Singh read the diary & the day ended after preparing for the street play.

Dt. 14 December, 2023: On this Thursday, Mr. Ramesh Thakur explained the importance of yoga with various examples & gave yoga lessons to the students through demonstration. Later, Shramdaan was given after tea breakfast as per daily routine. This Shramdaan was of a different kind. Students did intellectual Shramdaan. Suddenly the school principal asked NSS students to take over the school as all the teachers in the school had gone for training. So students ran the school, some headmaster, some Marathi teacher, some History teacher, Maths teacher, some P.T. teacher & played the role of teacher perfectly.

In the afternoon intellectual session Mrs. Kalpana Gogat, a professor of the Marathi department of her college, guided her about the literature & social life of Sant. In it, he guided through the teachings of Sant, like Sant Dnyaneshwar, Saint Tukaram, Saint Ramdas, etc. In the second intellectual area, Hon'ble Mr. Daulat Patil informed the students about life through poems encouraging the students who lead today's young generation. After that the famous king of laughter from Uran Hon'ble Shri. Sanjivan Mhatre gave guidance about **Reading culture & today's youth**. Mr. Sanjivan Mhatre said how important reading is for students because as the saying goes, students should read books on various subjects. In his book Present Perfect, he briefly told the students and through his guidance, he gave a message about how reading can change the direction of the students. After the meal, the Saptrangi Group read the diary & the day ended with the preparation of the street play.

Dt. 15 December 2023: In the morning, Mr. Ramesh Thakur gave detailed information to the students about diet, what to eat & what to avoid & practice yoga. After tea & breakfast, all the volunteers went to clean the Navasheva station premises & swept the entire station premises. Chicken & bread were given to the campers on behalf of the villagers.

In an intellectual session after lunch, Dr. A.R. Chavan delivered a lecture on **"Reality of Fiscal & Monetary Policy in India"**. Then Hon'ble Jaywant Thakur, founder of Friends of Nature, Chirner, and Hon'ble Shri Rakesh Shinde gave detailed information about non-venomous snakes, moderately poisonous snakes and venomous snakes & cleared the society's misconceptions about snakes in the minds of the students & gave detailed information on plastic pollution. After that, food was prepared by Prerna Sangh. Everyone had dinner & after the team read the diary together, the day ended with the preparation of street play.



Dt. 16 December, 2023: On Saturday morning, Hon'ble Mr. Ramesh Thakur taught yoga & Yog Nidra to the students & gave the mantra of a healthy life & after tea & breakfast preparations were made for the health check-up camp. In collaboration with health concept charities, in Mumbai. Dr. Vedanti's Team had come for a health check-up camp. She treated the patients with homeopathy medicines, BP, sugar, anaemia, joint pain, etc. She treated the school students & village citizens for many diseases. The camp got a good response. Principal Dr. Baliram N. Gaikwad visited the camp & inspected the work of the campers & appreciated the students.

Then in the afternoon session Hon'ble Mr. Prashant Patil (Founder, Warriors Academy Bokadweera) & Hon'ble Vishal Patwardhan (MPSC Teacher) guided the students about Army, Navy, Police, Direct Service Recruitment Training & conducted Shot Put, 100m Running, 800m Running, running methods, etc. were demonstrated & the students were given preliminary warm-up & competitive exam preparation, etc. & the volunteer's question was resolved through question & answer. The students made this session popular. After that, the students for the street play & the students enjoyed the food prepared by Saptarangi group. The day ended after preparations for the street play.


Dt. 17 December, 2023: After Yoga prayer, the students organized a rally in the villages explaining the importance of cleanliness after morning breakfast. In the evening session, all the groups of volunteers presented street plays on their respective topics in the public forum of the village. Ekta Group presented a street play on the topic of "Beti Bachao, Beti Padhao", Saptarangi group on "Environment Conservation", Surajya group on "Population Growth Is A Problem", We Together group on "HIV AIDS Awareness", Prerna Group presented street plays on various topics, etc. & tried to create awareness among the villagers. The day ended after dinner.

Dt. 18 December, 2023: Written feedback was taken from volunteer students after yoga & pranayama as per daily routine. After that, the final program was prepared. Raigad Bhushan Hon'ble Mr. L.B. Patil said that students should develop social commitment in themselves. Principal Dr. Baliram N. Gaikwad expressed his thoughts on this occasion. The program was presided over by Hon'ble Mr. Ramesh Thakur (College Development Committee Member) Sarpanch of Pagote Village Hon'ble Mr. Kunal Patil, President of Village Improvement Committee, Hon'ble Mr. Prakash Narayan Bhoir, Vice President of Village Improvement Committee, Hon'ble Mr. Surendra Patil, Treasurer Hon'ble Mr. Rishikesh Mhatre, Principal of Raigad Zilla Parishad School Pagote Hon'ble Mr. Ananth Sadashiv Patil & all Gram Panchayat members were



present on the occasion. The program was moderated by Kumar Amit Gaikwad, the guests were introduced by Kumari Mayuri Patil & the report was ready by Kumari Shital Bagul.
