



Department of Lifelong Learning & Extension (DLLE) Annual Report for the Academic Year 2025-2026



Vision and Mission: - "Reach to Unreached".

The Department of Lifelong Learning & Extension (DLLE) aims to "Reach the Unreached" by engaging students in community upliftment activities, focusing on the underprivileged.

Objectives for the year:

- Sensitize students to social issues.
- Enhance emotional quotient, skills, and leadership through event management opportunities.
- The department strives to make extension a key dimension of the university system, driving social change.

Extension Projects Selection: - DLLE selected two vocational projects:

- Career Project (CP): 29 students participated
- Anna Poorna Yojana (APY): 48 students participated
- Student Managers: 3 students participated

Total participation: 80 students. These projects aimed to provide practical exposure and skill development opportunities.

Highlights of Extension Activities: -

1. **First Term Training & Orientation:** A training meeting was held on July 14, 2025, to introduce extension students to DLLE projects, activities, and procedures. The meeting aimed to familiarize students with DLLE's work and expectations, setting the stage for their extension projects. 101 students & 3 teachers were present for the training.
2. **First DLLE Committee Meeting:** The first-term meeting of DLLE committee members was held on July 25, 2025, to discuss on planning of extension activities & budgeting

for the activities. This meeting laid the groundwork for the department's outreach initiatives.

3. **Raksha Bandhan Celebration:** DLLE students sold Rakhis made by specially-abled students of Swami Brahmanand Pratishthan Seabirds Special School, Bori-Uran, as part of the APY project. The activity, conducted on July 25, 2025, raised Rs. 2,450 with the participation of 40 students and 3 teachers. This initiative supported the specially-abled students and promoted social inclusion
4. **Pre-Planning Food Festival Meeting:** Pre-planning meeting for the Food Festival was conducted with 22 students and 3 teachers dated 29th July, 2025.
5. **University Level First Term Training:** On behalf of the College DLLE Unit, two students and one teacher attended the First Term Training program conducted at Bhavana Trust Degree College of Commerce & B.Sc., Deonar, Mumbai, on August 2, 2025. The training aimed to equip participants with the skills and knowledge required for effective implementation of extension activities during the academic year 2025–26.
6. **Conducted Food Festival:** We conducted a Food Festival under the APY project in college on 6th August 2025. The total sales by 7 stall holders offering different dishes amounted to Rs. 11940/- within 2 hours. 172 students & 8 teachers participated in this activity.
7. **Visit to Sea-Bird Special School:** DLLE students visited Seabirds Special School as part of their extension activity, interacting with specially-abled students and learning from their teachers. The visit aimed to promote empathy, understanding, and social responsibility. 55 students & 6 teachers participated in this visit on 19th September, 2025.
8. **Sold of Diya Products :** DLLE students sold Diwali products made by specially-abled children from Swami Brahmanand Pratishthan Seabird Special School, Bori - Uran, raising Rs. 2970/-. This initiative promoted social awareness and supported the specially-abled students. 43 students & 3 teachers participated in this activity on 10th October, 2025.
9. **Second Term Training at College:** A college-level training program evaluated students' project works on October 10, 2025. The program aimed to assess progress

and guide students for further improvement. 66 students & 6 teachers participated in this training activity.

- 10. Reading Inspiration Day Celebration:** To commemorate the birth anniversary of Dr. A.P.J. Abdul Kalam, Reading Inspiration Day was celebrated on 18th October 2025. The day was observed with the objective of promoting reading habits, curiosity, and lifelong learning among students and faculty members. 57 students and 6 teachers actively took part in the event. The enthusiastic turnout reflected strong interest in fostering a reading culture within the institution and among the general public. The celebration successfully highlighted Dr. Kalam's vision of "ignited minds" and reinforced the importance of reading as a tool for personal and intellectual growth.
- 11. Samvidhan Jagar Abhiyan Din:** On 21st November, 2025, program conducted to spread awareness about the Indian Constitution, its values & our duties as citizens. Students gained key insights to become responsible contributors to the nation's growth. The initiative reinforced the importance of understanding our Constitution as the foundation of democracy. 74 students and 4 teachers actively took part in the event.
- 12. Second DLLE Committee Meeting:** The second-term DLLE committee meeting was held on November 25, 2025, to review first-term extension projects, finalize project preparations, and discuss upcoming events, including Utopia 6.0 and the Udaan Festival in January 2026.
- 13. Samvidhan Jagar Abhiyan Speech Training:** On 29th November 2025, a training session was conducted for students on delivering speeches about the importance of Indian Constitution Day. 12 students and 2 teachers participated in this training session.
- 14. University Level Second Term Training:** DLLE representatives from the college attended the University Second Term Training program conducted at Ramniranjan Anandilal Potdar College of Commerce & Economics, Matunga, Mumbai, on December 3, 2025. The meeting covered guidelines for the preparation of project reports for 10 grace marks and discussed upcoming events of the UDAAN Festival scheduled for January 2026. Two students and one teacher participated in the program.

15. **Celebration of National Consumer Day:** On 24th December 2025, National Consumer Day was celebrated at college to raise awareness about consumer rights and responsibilities. The event successfully promoted consumer awareness and education among students. 67 students and 6 teachers participated in the program.
16. **UTOPIA: 6.0 Collegiate and Inter-Collegiate Event:** DLLE College Unit organized 08 events from January 15th to 17th, 2026 showcasing students' creativity and teamwork. The events involved extensive preparations, including decoration, pamphlet designing, campaigning, and registration. 17. **Organized University Udaan Festival:** The UDAAN FESTIVAL - The Flight of Extension 2026 was organized by Uran Education Society's College of Management & Technology, Konkan Gyanpeeth, Uran College of Commerce & Arts, Uran, in collaboration with the University of Mumbai's Department of Lifelong Learning & Extension (DLLE) on 23rd Jan 2026. An annual event organized by the University of Mumbai to create awareness about social issues, promote extension work, and enhance student skills. **(A detailed report of which has been attached herewith.)**
18. **Participation in University Udaan Festival:** 14 students & 2 teachers participated at University UDAAN Festival held at UES, College of Management & Technology Uran on 23rd Jan.2026.
19. **Celebrated World Consumer Right Day:** On 18th March 2026, we celebrated World Consumer Right Day to create awareness & spread importance of Consumer Rights. 80 students & 10 teachers participated in this program.
20. **Completion of 120 hours of DLLE Activities:** The Core Projects of the DLLE activities were submitted by the students by 31st March 2026, and all University procedures and documentation were completed before 16th April 2026. A total of 75 students submitted project reports, which were certified by DLLE, University of Mumbai.

Achievements of DLLE Activities:-

- The UDAAN FESTIVAL - The Flight of Extension 2026 was **organized** by Uran Education Society's College of Management & Technology, **Konkan Gyanpeeth, Uran College of Commerce & Arts, Uran**, in collaboration with the University of Mumbai's Department of Lifelong Learning & Extension (DLLE) on 23rd Jan 2026. An annual

event organized by the University of Mumbai to create awareness about social issues, promote extension work, and enhance student skills.

The University UDAAN Festival 2026 was a grand success. A total of 424 students and teachers from 20 colleges across Navi Mumbai and Raigad district participated in the festival. The event aimed to promote holistic development and social responsibility among students through various competitions and activities.

- The college participated in the Udaan Festival competitions with great enthusiasm. The students secured the **Second Prize** in the **Street Play Competition** and a **Consolation Prize** in **Creative Writing**. The festival provided students with a valuable opportunity to exhibit their talent, creativity, and teamwork beyond the classroom.
- Ms. Vimal Isha Rambabu (FYBAF), Ms. Khan Amina Shamsuddin (SYBCOM), and Ms. Mhatre Sakshi Satish (TYBAF) were appreciated as **Best Extension Student** by the DLLE College Unit.
- Mr. Kanojiya Niraj Sunil (FYBCOM) and Ms. Gudekar Mukta Ganesh were appreciated as **Best Extension Student Manager** by the DLLE College Unit.
- The college successfully organized the intercollegiate event UTOPIA 6.0 in 2026, featuring 08 events conducted within the constraints of a limited budget and infrastructure.
- Prof. V. S. Indulkar, Field Coordinator for Raigad District, DLLE, University of Mumbai, has served the department for 18 years from 2008–09 to 2025–26. He conducted training sessions for DLLE students on extension activities at multiple colleges including Uran Education Society's College of Management & Technology, Uran; Karnala Sports Academy Barns College of Arts, Science & Commerce, Panvel; CKT Arts, Science & Commerce College, Panvel; and S.P.M. Arts, Commerce & Science College, Chondhi, Alibag. He was felicitated at the UDAAN Festival 2026 for his long-standing contribution.

- Students were sensitized to various social issues through structured extension activities, fostering awareness and social responsibility.
- Activities were designed to ensure easy implementation of extension work, enabling wider student participation and community outreach.

- Event management opportunities provided to students enhanced their emotional quotient, interpersonal skills, and leadership qualities through hands-on experience.

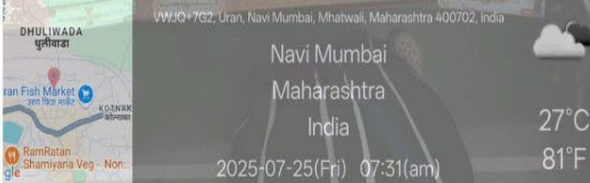
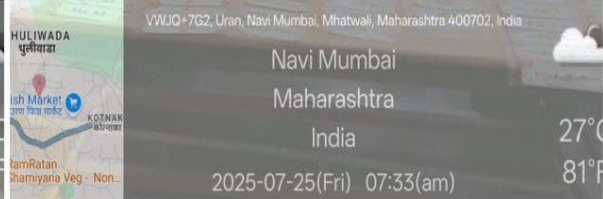

- This work would not have been possible without the support of the teaching and non-teaching staff of our college. I express my sincere thanks to one and all.

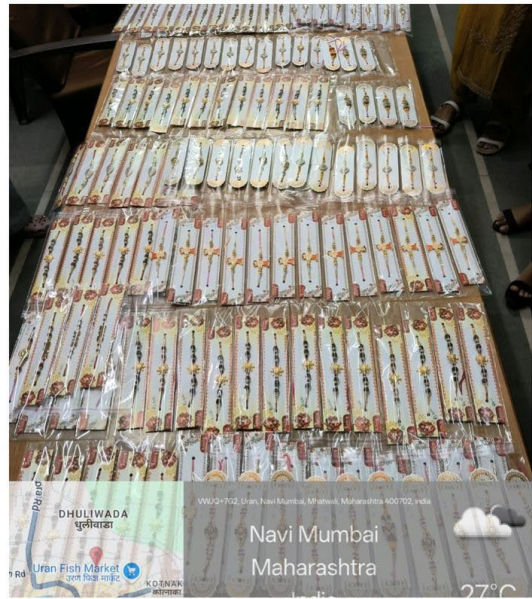

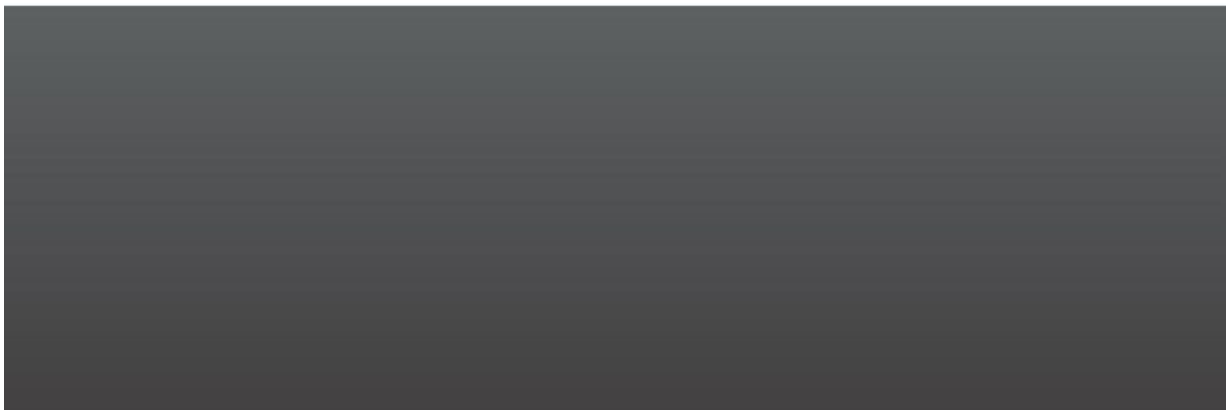

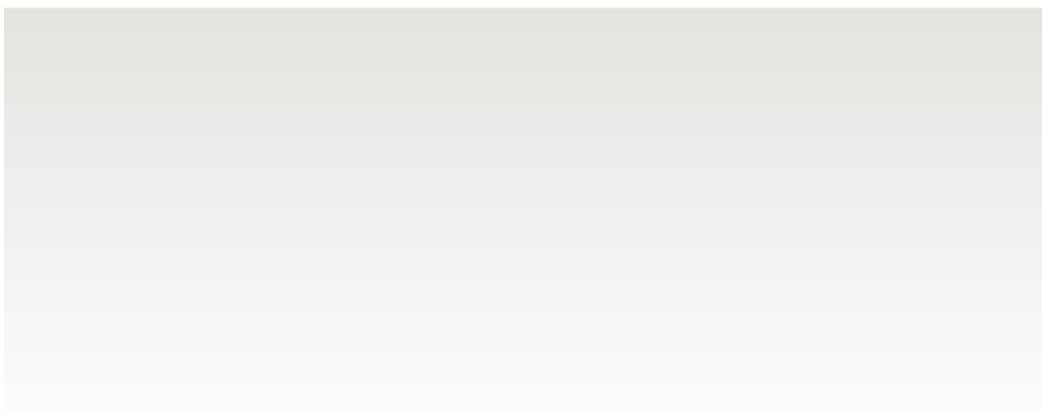
